Practical Solutions to Challenges in Implementing Global Reporting Format (GRF) in the Asia/Pacific Region

CONTENT

Global Reporting System and Format for Assessing and Reporting Runway Surface Conditions (GRF) is a new ICAO methodology for assessing and reporting runway surface conditions, which will become applicable on 4 November 2021. It ensures a harmonized assessment and reporting of runway conditions and correspondingly improved flight crew assessment of take-off and landing performance.

This webinar provides a timely opportunity to all parties involved in the implementation of GRF for runway surface conditions, to seek clarifications on the new methodology and to discuss solutions to the common challenges encountered in their efforts to put GRF in place. Representatives from ICAO and aerodrome operators, aeronautical information service providers, airline pilots, and air traffic control will present their experiences, especially in how they overcame the challenges encountered, and their views on how these should best be overcome. A question period will follow.
